## SITE MANAGER RESPONSIBILITIES:

### RESPONSIBILITIES WILL INCLUDE, BUT NOT BE LIMITED TO:

- 1. Maintaining open communication lines between the drill crew and management
- 2. Overseeing the quality of work ensures drilling and survey accuracy.
- 3. Supplying the drill crew daily with the necessary safety and legal documentation.
- 4. Over-inspection of all maintenance done on drilling equipment and signing off job cards received from artisans.
- 5. Maintain open communication lines between departments: Mining, Ventilation, Survey, Geology, Technicians, Engineering, Management, and the Safety Department.
- 6. Signing off on drilling survey notes in time before drilling commences.
- 7. Perform weekly VFLs and PTOs on the drill crew.
- 8. Ensure compliance with all safety-related requirements and standards.
- 9. Continues on-the-job training.
- 10. Perform daily safety meetings.
- 11. Site inspections and preparation planning before drilling commences.
- 12. Identify all short cummings at the drill site.
- 13. Conduct or ensure weekly maintenance on the machine and trailers when required.
- 14. Conduct weekly safety checks and visual site inspections underground at each drill site.
- 15. Timekeeping and overtime management.
- 16. Ordering and delivering of spares on the mine.
- 17. Calibration of the survey tool, safe handling of survey equipment, and ensuring the survey tool battery is charged at all times.
- 18. Ensure precise and complete surveying of drilled holes.
- 19. Ensure collar positions are established by the survey department.

- 20. Provide and ensure survey data is accurate and delivered to the geology department timeously and not compromised.
- 21. Daily safety talks with the drill crew and team leaders.
- 22. Daily signing off on the drill reports and engineering pre-start inspections received from the drill crew and artisans.
- 23. Daily feedback on progress to the production geologist.
- 24. Responsible for own safety and the crew.
- 25. Ensuring overall drill rig and equipment availability of 90% and above
- 26. Maintain drill budgets and prevent overspending.
- 27. Creating safe standard operating procedures: SOPs
- 28. Obeying all legal instructions.
- 29. Responsible for reaching daily, monthly, and yearly drilling targets.
- 30. Attending all required meetings as determined by management.
- 31. Ensure the required PPE is issued, signed for, always available, and used by all involved at the drill site.
